Class VI Road Restrictions

Effective on 1st of December each year, and until the yearly posted road ban is lifted, no person shall operate any wheeled vehicles on the following roadways;

Carter Notch Road beyond Ballentine Landing

Black Mountain Road beyond the gate at 551 Black Mountain Road

Violations of this rule, along with other civil and criminal penalties, may result in a \$100.00 fine for the first offense and 250.00 for any subsequent offenses. In addition, violators will be responsible for any and all direct and indirect expenses related to any acts associated with recovery, removal and/or storage of vehicles stranded or abandon.

Exemptions

- Property owners, or their accompanied guests, are exempt from the regulation when traveling to and from the owner's property.
- Municipal highway work vehicles and emergency services vehicles are exempt while in the performance of their official functions.
- Commercial Fuel delivery, agricultural equipment involved in farming, commercial milk delivery and vehicles used in the production and transportation of maple syrup are exempt.
- Licensed hunters, while lawfully engaged in hunting or retrieving game. Nothing in this exemption suggests or infers it is lawful to hunt from a vehicle.
