

Bartlett Jackson Transfer Station Committee

Meeting minutes: April 4, 2018

Attendance: Jackson Selectmen: John Allen, Bob Thompson, And Dick Bennett

Bartlett Selectmen: Gene Chandler, David Patch, Vicki Garland

Civil Engineer Burr Phillips and Transfer Station Manager Donald Miller

Meeting opened at 04:30 PM.

Thompson made a motion to accept the contract to do Phase III at the transfer station. Bennett seconded the motion. Roll call vote was unanimous. Chandler as Chairman of the Bartlett Jackson Transfer Station Committee was authorized to sign the contract with Louis Memolo which he did.

Engineer Phillips gave the committee an update on Phase III.

Engineer Phillips and Manager Donald Miller talked about recycling as well as whether we plan on having an employee up at recycling full time.

Engineer Phillips discussed that the Prima American plant in Groveton is nearly ready to open and they are now accepting bailed #2, (high-density polyethylene) #4 (low-density polyethylene) and #5 (polypropylene) plastics. They don't pay for the plastic but they will typically pay half of the hauling costs and there are no tipping fees. Their plant is about an hour and ten minutes from Jackson and this would get rid of plastics you can't sell without putting it into a landfill.

The Committee looked at a traffic plan from Larry Garland. The Committee decided to wait to change until the paving is done as we are not sure this idea would work.

The winter maintenance was discussed and a follow up will be done on this.

Garland brought up the subject of Harts Location using the transfer station. This will be discussed at the next meeting.

There being no further items to discuss the meeting was adjourned at 05:25 PM.
