- a. Selectmen's Meeting June 14, 2022

Chairman Campbell made a motion to accept the minutes as written, seconded by John Allen. All approved.

4. For Selectmen Discussion and/or Motions:

a. <u>FD Generator – Jay</u>

Chief Henry has received one quote for a generator from the same company that installed generators for both the Twin Mountain and North Conway fire stations. The size options are 50kw and 100kw. The cost difference is minimal, so Chief Henry recommends the larger generator. Chief Henry is going to get another quote, and this will be discussed further at a future meeting.

Chief Henry wanted to make a comment that the UTV that was purchased two years ago with association and donated money has been a great investment. The UTV has helped with many calls.

Also, inspections are on schedule.

b. Forest Fire Pay – need signatures

The Jackson Fire Department provided some help with the Crawford Notch Fire.

Frank DiFruscio made a motion to sign the submission to receive money from the state for the Crawford Notch Fire that was in May, seconded by John Allen. All approved.
