## TOWN OF JACKSON JACKSON. NEW HAMPSHIRE NOTICE OF ORDINANCE USE OF TOWN ROADS/SIDEWALKS

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Selectmen has amended JACKSON TOWN ORDINANCE (originally effective 1 July 1966) and adopted the ordinance as amended at its meeting of 22 November 1976, and confirmed the same at its meeting of 29 November 1976, to be effective 15 December 1976.

Resolved by the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Jackson, New Hampshire acting pursuant to the powers vested in them by RSA 41:11 and all other powers that:

- It shall be unlawful for any person to park or abandon a truck, bus, automobile, minibike, motorcycle or other motor vehicle in a public right of way:
- On the east side of Route 16A from the Wildcat Tavern south to Robinwood Inn Drive.
- On the north side of Green Hill Road (also known as Iron Mountain Road) from Route 18 to the residence of Walter V. Jones, Jr.
- c. On the south side of Route 16A from Route 16 east to the
- entrance to the Jack Frost Shop parking lot.
  d. On either the east side or west side of Route 16B (also known as Carter Notch Road or Middle Road) from Route 16A to the top of Jackson Falls Hill, exclusive of the Visitors' Parking Area.
- e. On any other Town road or State Highway (Route 16A, 16B) within the Town of Jackson in violation of any posted signs relating to parking (permitted or not; time limitations; or manner of parking).
- Any vehicle found parked in violation of the foregoing provisions may be removed to a suitable storage place by the police or on order of a Selectman with the expense thereof to be borne by the owner or person in charge of the vehicle involved.
- 3. It shall be unlawful for any truck, bus, automobile, minibike, motorcycle, golf cart or other motor vehicle to be driven or ridden on any sidewalk in the Town of Jackson at any time.
- 4. It shall be unlawful for any bicycle to be used or operated during the hours of darkness on any Town road or State Highway (Route 16, 16A, 16B) within the Town of Jackson unless such bicycle shall be equipped with a light (which is working) on the front end and a light (which is working) or a reflector on the rear fender.
- Any person who is the owner or operator of a truck, bus, automobile, minibike, motorcycle or other motor vehicle upon conviction shall be fined not more than \$50.00 for each violation of section 1 of this ordinance.
- Any person who is the owner or operator of a truck, bus, automobile, minibike, motorcycle, Golf cart or other motor vehicle upon conviction shall be fined not more than \$20.00 for each violation of section 3 of this ordinance.
- 7. Any person who is the owner or operator of a bicycle upon conviction shall be fined not more than \$20.00 for each violation of section 4 of this ordinance.

This ordinance shall be effective 15 December 1976.
