Addition of a Solar Energy System Ordinance: The discussion will be on a proposed amendment to the Jackson Zoning Ordinance to establish a Solar Energy System Ordinance. The purpose of the ordinance is to accommodate Solar Energy Systems and distributed generations resources in appropriate locations, while protecting the public's health, safety, and welfare. To help accomplish this purpose, only Roof-mounted or Ground-mounted Solar Energy Systems that are accessory uses, or Community-scale Solar Energy Systems that have Solar Land Coverage of no more than 1 acre are permitted.
