Ordinance for the Inspection of Hotels, Rooming and Lodging Establishments, and Other Places of Public Assembly

Pursuant to RSA 155:1, et. seq., the Town of Jackson hereby adopts the following ordinance to protect the health and safety of persons who may occupy hotels, tenement houses, public buildings, schoolhouses, places of assembly as defined in RSA 155:17, I, and other buildings used as places of public resort in the Town of Jackson. The Jackson Fire Department or its designee shall be authorized to inspect such places from time to time as set forth herein and shall apply all applicable rules and regulations including but not limited to NFPA 101 (2015 Ed.) for new and existing hotels, dormitories, rooming and lodging establishments.

The Jackson Fire Department or its designee shall coordinate a convenient time with the owners or manager of buildings subject to this ordinance to schedule a safety inspection.

Pursuant to RSA 155:4, the Jackson Fire Department or its designee shall, when conducting an inspection, notify and hear all parties interested, and may thereupon direct such alterations as may be necessary in any building or hall in accordance with this ordinance, and may order such building or hall to be closed until the alterations are made. The proceedings of such hearing shall be recorded in the records of the town or district.

Per RSA 155:5, every person aggrieved by any decision of such inspectors may appeal therefrom to the superior court. The court, upon reasonable notice, may inquire into the facts by a committee or otherwise and affirm or overrule the order appealed from, and may make such further orders as justice may require.
