The Agenda will include a public hearing on an application for a variance from Jackson septic system requirements as they apply to the construction of a new three bedroom home located on Sugar Hill Lane (Map V-4, Lot 8), submitted by William and Francis O'Shea of Glen, NH. The proposed residence as designed does not conform to the current Town of Jackson Septic System Design requirements.
